

Fish Sachet Pattern

- 1. Cut out pattern on dashed line.
- 2. Place pressed fabric pieces right sides together.
- 3. Pin pattern to fabric and trim fabric to pattern.
- 4. Place tracing paper with chalk side towards fabric between pattern and fabric.
- 5. Trace solid line on to fabric, including two start and stop lines and other markings.

 Make sure you can clearly see chalk marks on fabric.
- 6. Unpin pattern from fabric, being careful not to shift the two pieces, and repin.
- 7. Sew on marked line, backstitching at Start and Stop lines.
- 8. Cut out notches and slits as marked.
- 9. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and turn right side out through the hole.
- 10. Use a tool to poke out the tail and the nose, then press the seams.
- 11. Use a funnel to fill your fish with dried lavender, packing it in with a a chopstick or other tool.
- 12. Hand sew the hole closed and sew on the button eyes.
- 13. Enjoy your fish!
